

Frequently Asked Questions About Volunteering at Rock Ranch:

Q: Do I need to have horse experience?

A: No, we will work with you & have you shadow other volunteers to learn the ropes! We work together as a team, you are never on your own, and we will not put you in a position of volunteering until you feel comfortable.

Q: Are there volunteer opportunities that don't involve working with horses?

A: Yes, some of our programs need volunteers to help with things other than the horses.

Q: How old do I need to be to volunteer?

A: The minimum age to volunteer is 14.

Q: What are the physical requirements?

A: Volunteers need to be able to lift a saddles onto a horse and walk in the sand in the arena & in our outside areas.

Q: What are the hours for volunteering?

A: Most of the hours are late afternoon/early evening during the week, which are for our student lessons, but we do have some events that occur in the morning or early afternoon as well. In the summer, volunteers are mainly needed in the morning to help with lessons.
